1st MidAmerica Credit Union has established a scholarship program to help provide educational funding for our young members.

Scholarship Amount

1st MidAmerica will award five, 2021 graduating high school seniors, \$1,000 non-renewable scholarships for educational expenses.

Deadline

Completed applications and all documents must be received by 1st MidAmerica no later than Wednesday, March 31, 2021. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Eligibility Requirements

1. Applicant must be a member of 1st MidAmerica and the account must be in good standing.
2. Applicant must be a 2021 high school graduating senior.
3. 1st MidAmerica employees, directors and their families are not eligible.

It is the responsibility of the applicant to see that all information is received by 1st MidAmerica by the deadline. All materials submitted become property of 1st MidAmerica.

Applicant Must Submit:

1. An official high school transcript for the most current semester available, with the total cumulative grade point average (GPA) on the transcript. Transcript must be received by 1st MidAmerica in a sealed envelope by the deadline of Tuesday, March 31, 2021.
2. A completed 1st MidAmerica Application, included in this packet, along with a typed, double-spaced, 300-500 word original written essay on the following topic: 1st MidAmerica Credit Union is a community supporting organization. We host fundraisers, make donations to area organizations, and participate in local programs such as food drives and charity walks. **If you were given \$10,000 and 30 days to make an impact on your community, what would you do?**
3. Two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a teacher.

Awarding of Scholarships

Decisions are made by the 1st MidAmerica Scholarship Committee. All decisions are final.

Important

Please do not send any part of the application package separately except the transcript, which may be mailed directly from your high school, and do not include any extra materials. Scholarship applications will not be considered unless all required information is received by the deadline of March 31, 2021. Applicants are encouraged to submit their applications early.
