The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not appropriate for travelers who use wheelchairs, walkers, and other mobility assistance devices.

Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).

Luggage handling is not available when getting on and off the public ferries between Athens, Mykonos, and Santorini. You will need to carry your own luggage for approximately 200 feet each way. As the ferry is the main connection between the mainland and several islands, you can expect large crowds and personnel directing travelers to their destinations with a very quick turnaround.

For those on the Ancient Delos optional tour, this will require a flat walk of up to 3 hours and 1 mile in the sun (weather-dependent), with no shaded areas.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at the time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

In order to access the Acropolis archeological site, you will be required to climb about 50-60 steep, uneven steps and walk over rugged terrain with loose stones and without railings.

Due to ferry schedules on some departures, you may be required to depart the hotel as early as 5:30 a.m. Should this be the case, a boxed breakfast will be provided in place of the regular hotel breakfast.

Due to a limited number of tickets for the Acropolis, travelers who book within 60 days of departure may be waitlisted until tickets can be confirmed.

*The "Ancient Delos: Apollo's Sacred Island" option must be purchased at least 10 days prior to departure.

**Island Hopping Cruise option is subject to weather and sea conditions.

Due to the nature of this itinerary, both 3- and 4-star hotels that may be located in the vicinity of historic centers will be utilized.

Make the most of a day at leisure and see all that Greece has to offer with an island-hopping adventure and dinner. Set sail for the tiny islet of Nea Kameni – an uninhabited island that is formed on an active volcano. Make your way up the side of the still-active volcano with your local guide, pausing at the top of the crater for unparalleled views. After exploring, return to the boat to set off for your next destination – Palea Kameni. Similar to Nea Kameni, this islet is also of volcanic descent. Jump into the water and swim to the island's rejuvenating hot springs, where you will find ethereal sulfuric waters and therapeutic mud - or choose to relax on the boat. Continue on to Thirassia, an authentic island that embodies the traditional culture of Greece. Later, make a stop close to Oia where you may catch the sun setting, marveling as the sky turns shades of orange and gold before sailing back to port. This option needs to be pre-purchased one week prior to departure. Most visitors never make it past the harbor. This morning, you will. The hilltop village of Ano Mera offers a quieter, deeply local side of Mykonos – explore a working monastery, step into a small local museum, and taste a traditional Mykonian sweet straight from the village bakery. At a family-run cheese shop, you'll discover why cheese-making here is less a craft and more a calling – generations of know-how poured into every wheel of xinotiro, kopanisti, and vrasto. Sample each alongside fresh-made yogurt, then settle in for a home-style lunch at the farmer's table. *Duration: Approximately 7.5 hours.* Please note a minimum of 15 passengers is required. Transportation is included.

Ancient Delos: Apollo's Sacred Island**\$189 USD**

Take a step into the past with a half-day excursion to the island of Delos, the fabled birthplace of Apollo and Artemis. After a quick 30-minute boat ride, allow your guide to introduce you to this sprawling UNESCO site. See how the Greek myths intertwine with prehistoric ruins, passing through narrow streets from the Hellenistic age. Tour the awe-inspiring House of Dionysus, a relic from the 4th-century BC containing ancient mosaics and preserved columns. Day 11: Athens, Greece - Istanbul, Türkiye

Fly to Istanbul, Türkiye's most popular city. Considered to be the bridge between the East and the West, Istanbul is a central hub for intermingling cultures, complicated history, and legendary architecture. The city was the former capital of the Byzantine and Ottoman empires – which is seen through its blend of times-gone-by nostalgia and ever-evolving modernity. This evening, kick-start your exploration of Istanbul by sampling Turkish cuisine during dinner at a local restaurant. *Today dinner will be included.*

Day 12: Istanbul

Discover the city with a local guide. Start your day at the Blue Mosque,* where vibrant blue tiles line the building's opulent interior walls. Then, visit Topkapi Palace, former home to the Ottoman Sultans. After free time for lunch, continue exploring Istanbul with your local expert and visit Hagia Sophia, the Church of the Holy Wisdom. Make your way through the lively Grand Bazaar and Spice Market, surrounding yourself with artisan crafts, buzzing energy, and exciting vendors. Enjoy an evening at leisure. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 13: Istanbul

This morning, take in the high-rises and minarets of Istanbul's majestic skyline as you sail between two continents during a cruise of the Bosphorus Strait, which divides Europe from Asia. The remainder of the day is yours to spend however you choose! Explore the local boutiques or maybe taste the culture through Turkish favorites. Perhaps you will choose to go on an optional excursion to a Hammam Turkish bath, where you'll enjoy an authentic scrub and foam bath. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable as is climbing 3 flights of stairs. You can handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. You can expect some longer days balanced with free time. This level is not a fit for travelers that require mobility assistance devices.
